DUNE AREAS FOR NECTAR PLANTS

Nectar plants should be confined mostly along the rope fence, i.e., from the fence line in the protected side 2 meters or less; in the dune trail side 0.3 meter or less.

Notes: Dune grasses and sedges are not plotted.
